Farm Updates

Oh where, oh where has our sunshine gone? After checking the weather forecast, the next ten days will be cloudy with some rain here and there. We won't know how to act when we finally see the sun again! LOL!

But, with the cloudy weather comes eggs! Yes, our new pullets are starting to lay; the egg count improves every day. Pretty soon we will be awash in eggs. And, they are the best!

Here at Bowers Farm, we think honesty is the best policy. After starting with cows in 2010, we have only had to administer antibiotics to one cow in four years, and that was to 41 (not a Red Devon) for hoof rot. Well, this year the cows have been plagued with pink eye, an infection that can lead to blindness in cows if not treated properly. We have had to administer antibiotics to most of our herd, much to our chagrin. The last cow that was processed did not receive any antibiotics. We don't anticipate processing another cow until June or July of 2016, so the antibiotic should be well out of their system by then. We try to exhaust every avenue before taking these drastic steps with our animals. But sometimes we must take these steps to insure the health and well-being of the animal. We will be researching methods to ensure this doesn't happen in the future.


